




# Dabba Walla

– Mumbai Food Express –

In addition to the modules listed in the rulebook, there are further options for customising *Dabba Walla* to your own taste. These variants are labelled with one or more symbols and can be combined with each other as desired.

 = for 2 players    = for experts    = for families



## Variants

### The imaginary third player ()

#### Changes in setup:

After forming the draw pile, do not put the remaining cards back into the card box, but place them in a face-down pile next to the game board. Turn over the top card from this pile and place it clearly visible at the edge of the playing area.

#### Changes in the PICK-UP PHASE:

At the end of a turn in which you have placed the first Dabba tile on a new level in which none of you had previously placed a tile, draw **two cards from the pile at the edge of the playing area**. Secretly look at these cards, choose one of them and put it **face-up** on the card revealed during setup. Stack the revealed cards so that the bottom half of each card remains visible.

Put the other card back **on top or on the bottom** of the stack.

#### Example:

*If, at the end of the PICK-UP PHASE, one level marker is on the 5 and the other on the 7, you should have revealed a total of 7 cards.*

#### Changes in the DELIVERY PHASE:

The **imaginary third player** contributes exactly one card to each scoring round, which is added to your cards and chai tiles to determine the value of the scoring markers:

The top card (which was revealed last) for the top level, ..., and the bottom card (which was already revealed during setup) for level 1.


### Chai for tea connoisseurs (, )

#### Changes in setup:

No changes.

#### Changes in the PICK-UP PHASE:

When connecting a chai symbol, draw 2 (instead of 1) random chai tiles. Choose 1 chai tile to place face down in front of you and remove the other tile from the game by setting it aside face down.

 **Note:** Once the supply of chai tiles has been depleted, shuffle all formerly unselected chai tiles to form a new supply. Make sure that you do **NOT** shuffle the chai tiles **already used** in this game into the supply!

#### Changes in the DELIVERY PHASE:

No changes.

### Long game ()

#### Changes in setup:

If you would like to play longer and stack the dabbas higher, during setup add 1 card per person to the draw pile for each additional round.

#### Example:

*You want to play 16 rounds instead of 13 in a 3-player-game? Then you need 59 cards instead of 50.*

#### Changes in the PICK-UP/DELIVERY PHASE:

No changes.

### Tactical start ()

#### Changes in setup:

Instead of the quantity of cards specified in the rulebook, you will need:

2 players	3 players	4 players
39 cards	56 cards	73 cards

Instead of the usual 2, you now draw 4 cards. Look at these cards, keep 2 of them, and remove the other two from the game.

#### Changes in the PICK-UP/DELIVERY PHASE:

No changes.

### No "Take that!" ()

#### Changes in setup:

Sort out and put aside all the "-1" chai tiles and the "veto" chai tiles during setup.

#### Changes in the PICK-UP/DELIVERY PHASE:

No changes.
